QVAR®, an inhaled corticosteroid (ICS), is a maintenance medication that controls and reduces the inflammation of the airways. It is the number two ICS in the marketplace.
- Teva Respiratory is focused on improving patient outcomes and providing innovative solutions. While there currently is no cure for asthma, it can be managed effectively with proper prevention, treatment and care.
- Teva Respiratory is a brand division of Teva Pharmaceuticals, the largest manufacturer of branded and generic pharmaceuticals as measured by the number of prescriptions filled. In fact, one in six prescriptions filled in the United States is a Teva product; one in four is a Teva generic product.

### EVERY DAY IN AMERICA:

- **40,000** people miss school or work due to asthma.
- **5,000** people visit the emergency room due to asthma.
- **1,000** people are admitted to the hospital due to asthma.
- **11** people die from asthma.

### OVERALL:

- An estimated 20 million Americans suffer from asthma.
- Nearly 5 million asthma sufferers are under age 18.
- Asthma accounts for more than 10 million outpatient visits.
- Nearly half (44%) of the hospitalizations are for children.
- Asthma is the #1 cause of school absenteeism, accounting for more than 14 million total missed days of school.
- There are more than 4,000 deaths due to asthma annually.
- The annual cost of asthma is estimated to be nearly \$18 billion – direct costs account for nearly \$10 billion and indirect costs total \$8 billion (lost earnings due to illness or death).
